

Summer 1941 Scenario - European Map Only

Starts with Axis turn, Summer 1941. The Germans and Italians are at war with the British and have occupied most of the rest of Europe.

SETUP

In Replacements: Italian supply unit, German convoy, German supply x 2, British supply x 2, Soviet supply, US convoy

Not yet in game: German oil replacement

Reinforcement Track: All units scheduled to appear

Italian Units:

Tripoli: African Army, German Supply Unit, Italian Convoy

Sicily: Tactical

Naples: Regia Marina, Tactical

Italian Army in following areas: Rome, Turin, Greece

Vichy Units:

Algiers: Col Army

German Units:

Tobruk: DAK Panzer Army

German Atlantic Wall in following areas: Normandy, Lille, Low Countries

Paris: Army (Garrison)

Hamburg: Army (Garrison), Kriegsmarine

Narvik: Army (Garrison)

Helsinki: Finnish Army

Removed from Game: Landing Craft

Free setup anywhere in Germany, France, Hungary, Italy, or any German-controlled areas:

Panzer Armies x 4, Infantry Armies x 9, Tacticals x 6, Parachute

German possessions: Greece, Crete, Belgrade, Croatia, all of Norway, Poland, Finland, Denmark, Romania, Bulgaria, all of France except for Vichy France area (neutral nation)

Soviet units:

Brest-Litovsk: Fort, Front

Latvia/Lithuania: Front

Bessarabia: Front

Kiev: Front

Leningrad: Tactical, Front, Fort

Moscow: Tactical, Front

Sevastopol: Fort

Vladivostok: Front

British units:

Palestine: ANZAC army

Western Desert: 8th Mech, Tactical

Eastern Mediterranean: Flotilla

Malta: fort

Western Mediterranean: Carrier, Flotilla

Gibraltar: Fort
North Sea: Tactical
London: BEF Mech
Liverpool: Convoy, supply unit
Ceylon: Flotilla (off map; may not be called to Europe)
Manchester: Home Guard (remove during first British Reinforcement phase)

American Units:

Dutch Harbor: Flotilla (off map; may not be called to Europe)
North East Pacific: Flotilla (off map; may not be called to Europe)
Pearl Harbor: Army, Flotilla, Tactical (off map; may not be called to Europe)
Manila: Tactical (off map; may not be called to Europe)
Panama Canal: Carrier (off map; may not be called to Europe)
Anywhere in United States: Supply Unit, Army, Flotilla x 2

British possessions: Those marked on map but not already listed above as possessed by an Axis power, plus Syria. British also control the Dutch East Indies and get their production through the first turn in 1942.

American and British Reinforcements and Withdrawals:

SetUp - 2nd US Army is permanently assigned to Asia. All American carriers and reinforcement carriers must be assigned to Asia, except one carrier unit may be used in Europe for the first amphibious invasion in which American ground units invade, after which it returns to Asia.

One American supply unit is permanently assigned to Asia. As soon as three are in play anywhere on the European map, the next one must be permanently assigned to Asia.

Summer 1941 - Withdraw East Army of India to Asia

Winter 1941 - Withdraw ANZAC Forces to Asia. Americans must have one convoy off map in Asia at all times starting Winter 1941.

Summer 1942 - Withdraw British Carrier to Asia. Withdraw Marines to Asia.

Winter 1942 - Withdraw 6th US Army to Asia. Withdraw one Tactical to Asia.

Fall 1943 - In Fall 1943 one additional convoy must be permanently assigned to Asia. Both American Landing craft may be used in Europe. Starting in Fall 1943 one is permanently withdrawn to Asia.

Winter 1943 - Withdraw British 14th Army to Asia

Summer 1944 - Withdraw 8th US Army to Asia. Withdraw another Tactical to Asia.

Fall 1944 - Withdraw Strategic Bomber to Asia. Withdraw Heavy Strategic Bomber (B-29s) to Asia.

Spring 1945 - Withdraw Heavy Strategic Bomber to Asia.

Summer 1945 - Both Atomics and 10th Army are available for use in Europe.

British Replacements

All production stars on the European Map and, until the Axis turn of Spring 1942, 3 Dutch East Indies stars, plus the one star in India. On and after Spring 1942, only the European stars (and lend lease) are available. Lend lease is available as per the rules otherwise.

American Replacements

Once the US is in the war (Winter 1941), 2/3 of American replacements are designated for the European theater, rounding .5+ fractions up.

American production gears up as per the rules.
